



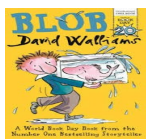

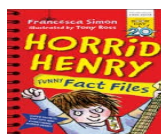

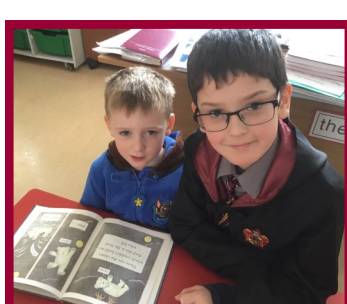

NSPCC & O2 Internet Safety Parents' Workshop

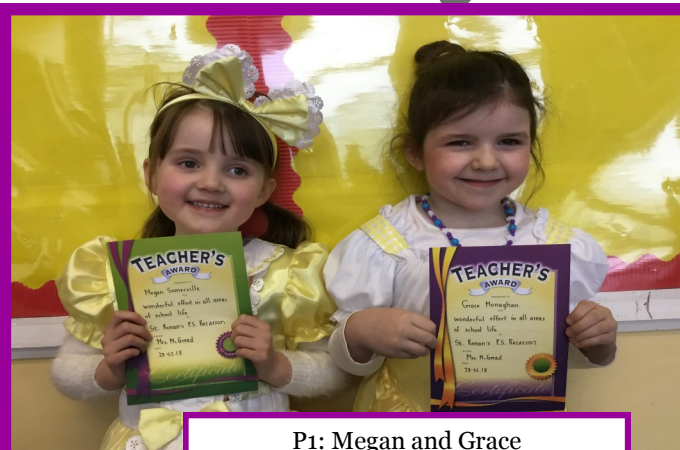
Open to parents from **all** year groups, this information session will give you advice and guidance on how to ensure your child stays safe online.

Parents felt our previous event was most informative and helped parents understand ways to keep children safe while online.

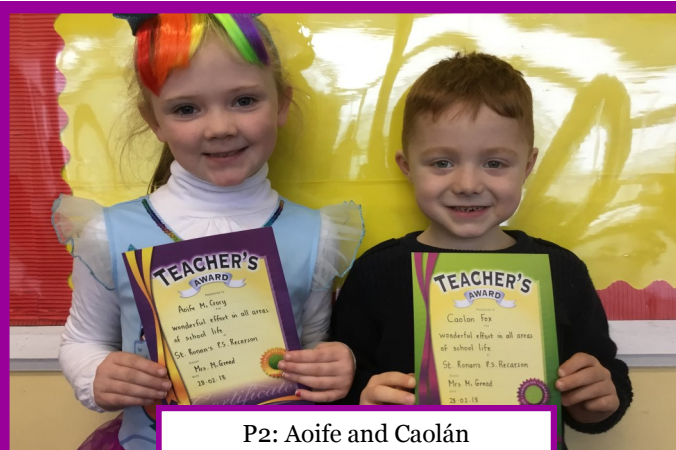
