Programme

Term 1

Thanks to the success of After Schools the programme last year, a variety of clubs is on offer. After The School programme must be financially viable to run. Registration - in advance is necessary to provide an indication of numbers committed to attending.

This, then, will help determine whether a club can go ahead as the school **must** cover costs from within the programme. The ongoing volunteering of a tutor free of charge is supporting the programme greatly to cover specific costs (e.g., equipment, materials etc.), to offer choice to the children and to be able to run clubs with smaller numbers and at a cheaper rate to all children.

The cost of attending each Club is <u>£30.00 per child</u> and is *non-refundable* once paid. *The cost of the Arts and Craft Club for P5-7 is £25.00 as not commencing until 10th October. This term clubs run for, 11 weeks with the exception of Arts and Crafts*. **Reduced rates are as follows: where 2 children or more from the same family are attending clubs = a reduced rate of £28.00 per child per club for the 11 week programme applies; £23.00 per child for the Arts and Craft Club. Where one child wishes to attend more than one club = a reduced rate of £28.00 per club applies.* Registration forms (with payment) should be returned as soon as possible and the closing date for the return of registration forms is <u>Wednesday 14th</u> <u>September 2016</u>. If spare places are available for a particular club, these may be made
